1. Counsel for the petitioner submits that although vide the first enquiry report, it was concluded that the injury was caused to the petitioner during the period of training and the same was not attributable to the petitioner, the matter was reopened, and vide the second enquiry report, the finding of the first enquiry report was reversed without any logic or basis.





2. Counsel submits that because of the injury caused during the training period, the disability of the petitioner aggravated and he deserved to be accorded a place of posting as per his medical category. But the respondents are now bent upon to terminate him, declaring him medically unfit.

3. Learned counsel Mr. Sanjay Sharma puts in appearance for all the respondents.

4. Let a copy of the writ petition be supplied to him.

5. Learned counsel appearing for the respondents prays for time to complete his instructions/file a reply.

6. Time prayed for is granted.

7. List the matter after four weeks.

8. Meanwhile, the services of the petitioner shall not be terminated.

9. Let the name of counsel Mr. Sanjay Sharma be reflected in the cause list as counsel for the respondent–Union of India.
